

INVITATION TO TENDER
SAINT JOHN AIRPORT
PHASE 1 – RESA & TERRAIN IMPROVEMENTS
CONTRACT NO. 18-0032-01

Qualified Contractors are hereby invited to submit a tender to undertake the Runway End Safety Area (RESA) and Terrain Improvements at the SAINT JOHN AIRPORT. Tenders, on supplied forms, will be received at the Saint John Airport Authority (4180 Loch Lomond Road, Saint John, NB, E2N 1L7, Canada) until 2:00 p.m. local time on Monday October 15, 2018.

The work generally involves the stripping, excavation, re-placement and compaction existing soils, placement of some imported granular base off all runway ends and re-instatement with salvaged topsoil and hydraulic seed. A portion of the existing Service Road will need to be Re-Aligned. Clearing an grubbing and rock removal and re-contouring of existing ground around under the approach to Runway 23 will involve heavy construction equipment and potential rock blasting.

A Bid Bond, Certified Cheque, or Irrevocable Letter of Credit in the amount of 10% of the tender amount and an Agreement to Bond must accompany each Tender. The successful Tenderer will be required to provide a 50% Performance Bond and a 50% Labour and Material Payment Bond upon execution of the Contract.

There will be a **PRE-BID MEETING/SITE INSPECTION on Thursday, October 4, 2018** at the Saint John Airport. The meeting will begin at 9:30 am at the **Airport Administration Office**. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Meeting is not mandatory but strongly recommended.

Tender Closing Date: Monday October 15, 2018 AT 2:00 P.M. LOCAL TIME.
